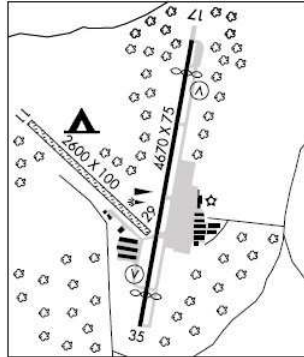

Camping

The lightly wooded campground is quiet besides the sound of departing aircraft. The site is located on-airport, north of runway 11. Taxi on Runway 29/11, then turn off to the dirt tie-down area. There are 21 sites, and facilities include picnic tables, fire-grills, clubhouse, water, flush toilets, & showers. The fee is \$8 per night. The campground is open from April through October. Nearby Attractions & Restaurants

Columbia was established as a gold rush town. Most of the downtown remained unchanged over the decades and now this state park is the one of the best ways to experience life in the bygone California goldrush era.

A short path in the parking lot by the airport office leads north into town. On the way (0.8mi) is the Columbia Grill, featuring standard diner fare. Licksillet is in a Victorian house at the corner of Columbia and State streets comes highly recommended
